“An orchestra plays within your mind”

Singing violins weave through your thoughts, voices engage in contrapuntal dialogue, timpani thunder in fierce exchanges, and waves of crescendo rock you gently in rhythm. A trombone storm banishes the last remnants of sleep from your bones, while staccato fireworks light up the sky of your spirit.

Then you open your eyes to find four musicians before you: a vocalist, a double bassist, a pianist, and a tenor saxophonist.

Helena Bühler (voice), Gian Luzi Niederhauser (bass), Maurice Storrer (tenor saxophone) and Felix Geidel (piano, composition) met at the Lucerne University of Music, where they discovered a shared passion for blending modern jazz improvisation with the harmonic depth of classical tradition.

With their chamber ensemble’s contrapuntal dialogues, spontaneous improvisations and unforgettable melodies, they conjure an orchestra in each listener’s imagination—whether you hear a baroque ensemble, a string orchestra or a full film-score soundscape, the choice remains yours, left deliciously unspoken.
